


WebMail

This article describes how to use the WebMail service to access your e-mail from any web browser, useful if you are using AOL to connect to the internet – as AOL does not support sending email by any account other than 'your screen name'.


You can use WebMail to send **and** receive email on the email account that reflects your domain name, and web site.

To use WebMail:

1. In the URL address bar of your web browser type in 'webmail' followed by your domain name. For example if your domain is compasscomputing.co.uk then enter webmail.compasscomputing.co.uk. The WebMail login page appears:



2. For the *Username* enter the e-mail address you want to check, e.g. sales@compasscomputing.co.uk.
3. Enter your password and click on the *Login* button. A list of your e-mail messages appears:
